Alistair Lowe from TBC was in attendance

Mr Lowe informed the meeting that he has drafted proposals which should reduce incidences of fly tipping in the parish. These include both covert and overt tactics.

Signs have been put up which initially appeared to have reduced the incidences but have now increased again

There may be some prosecutions, TBC is working with the police on a stop and search joint project

Following any prosecution there is a minimum fine of £200 or a fixed penalty of £400

There has been some identifying evidence in the waste

MW noted cameras are in situ and are being moved about the parish, there has been less activity, and considered the signs are effective overall

NPR cameras are ideal unless the areas are lit

Noted the timing of any tipping is mainly in the early hours but this does vary

Residents are encouraged to report any suspicions vehicles, note the registration number and report to Crime Stoppers
