Seven and a half million allocated for link road across A38, not sufficient to complete works

Tewkesbury is ripe for development but the 995 houses at Twigworth will come out of Gloucester need

Norton, Twigworth NDP is now complete and should work alongside Local Plan however in general does not carry much weight with developers

Even if agreed at vote will have to be immediately reviewed as is out of date

GCC supplementary planning guidance has now been produced, developers have to prove they have done everything in their powers to alleviate flooding but do not take into account any detrimental effect on surrounding area

JCS is a bad plan for TBC
