Land to the South of the Parish

Kissing gates 2020/2021

PC has ordered kissing gate from PROW. The two remaining expected kissing gates should be funded by GCC shortly. Members had received separate Emails from HG (PROW) on this subject.

List of approved three kissing gate sites below.

1) ESA 13 Cricket Ground entrance from PW's land farmed by SM.

2) ESA 31 Rear of Giles Cottage Garden into Moat Farm (County Coucil) land.

3) ESA 1A Severn Way at junction of JK's land and Moat Farm (County Council) land.

Members approved letters of intent being sent to Ben Cambridge Kingsholm cricket club and PW's estate in the month beginning 1st June asking if a contribution could be made towards the cost of providing the gate.
