

Sandhurst Parish Council, Footpath Report Minutes Item 16 on Monday 7 December 2020

In conjunction with the Footpath Report circulated the following Minutes were recorded concerning the report submitted.

Item 4 Construct Stile on permissive path to ESA 23 still on going from Minutes 2 November 2020.

Item 5 Mr. King did not want a kissing gate and therefore this had to be accepted. The existing stile be strengthened, and a step installed. Budget of £20 was agreed.

Action. **JPR to arrange**

Item 5(a) Members agreed the above kissing gate should be at the junction of ESA1A (Severn Way) / ESA19 exact point to be agreed by Chairman and Simon Booth. Budget £50.

Action. **Clerk to raise order for Simon Booth. JPR to check re Scan of Site with PROW as well as land ownership with RD.**

A large tree blocked the Severn Way close to the site. Action. **RD to consider.**

Item 7 Mr. Russell had received a letter regarding the Kissing Gate to be erected on the boundary between Giles Cottage and Moat Farm. Members agreed to the kissing gate being erected. Budget £50.

Action. **Clerk to raise order for Simon Booth. RD will deliver gate to site.**

Item 10 Finger Post at bottom of Rodway Lane. Still on going from 2 November Meeting.

Other items raised

Bridleway ESA2. JPR questioned the need for additional signing as no shooting (pheasants) was taking place. RD spoke about keeping to the paths.

Action. **JPR would liaise with RD over the matter.**

Budget. As there is an uncommitted budget of £235.78 Members agreed to purchase a kissing gate to be erected in Rodway Lane northern junction of ESA 16.

Action. **Clerk to place order with PROW. JPR to check re Scan of Site with PROW as well as land ownership.**

List of Kissing Gates. A new list would be compiled by JPR for Members to show where kissing gates could be placed in field locations and adjacent to the adopted highway.
