10. Planning - 22/01047/TPO The Carltons, Sandhurst Lane, Sandhurst.

DESCRIPTION: Remove the lower limbs of the Sycamore (Crown lifting) to create more light and prevent damage to the garden room.

The following comments were sent to Tewkesbury BC - When crown lifting trees, the large primary branches that grow directly from the trunk should be left. Removing them creates large wounds that can lead to decay. Crown lifting mature and older trees should be restricted to the secondary branches. This reduces recovery time and minimises stress for the trees. As recommended by the British standard for tree works BS3998:2010, crown lifting should be restricted to no more than 50% of the crown's height. This leaves the crown at least two thirds of the tree's total height.

It is a healthy tree that is being altered for cosmetic/convenience purposes. The tree must have been there long before the garden room was constructed.

The proposed branch is a large branch off the main trunk and removal can cause large wounds which can become extensively decayed, leading to long term problems and / or short-term instability.
